I had 10 interviews and got hired at Taco Bell with full time hours. I was so happy!!!!! I got hired on the spot and started a few days later. By the second week I was there I was basically full time.

Within three to four months I had a car and was waiting on an apartment that Guiding Light was remodeling. Now I'm in my apartment and absolutely love it everything was fully furnished and its so beautiful. Just seeing God's hand in everything was so amazing he gave me so much favor in my job. God has blessed me more than words can say! Julianne offered the apartment because of my progress and ability to maintain a full time job. I also now volunteer for the program. I haven't been so happy for so long. It is a true joy seeing God's grace and love move in my life. I never realized how much God loved me until I saw it and felt it especially in the last year. I am BLESSED because of the road God put me on to return home. Coming to Guiding Light was definitely part of His divine plan.

"A great attitude becomes a great mood, which becomes a great day which becomes a great year which becomes a great life." By UNKNOWN


"So it all begins in your mind, What you give power to has power over you, if you allow it." By UNKNOWN
