SUCCESS STORY

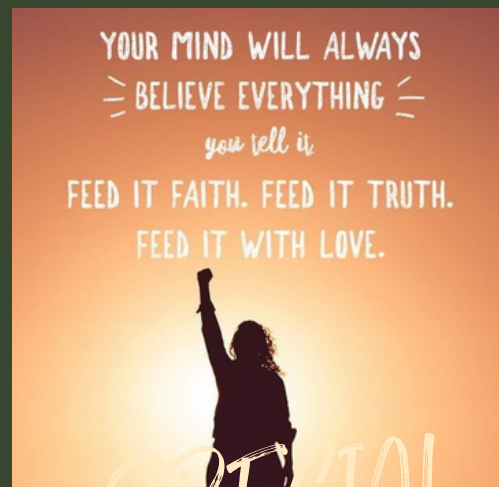
